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DESIGN FOR DISCIPLINE

In Matthew 18:15-20 Jesus gives us a simple pattern for what we often call "church discipline." In the pattern, we find a.....

Private Confrontation. "*...if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother...*" (Matthew 18:15). We often do the opposite by becoming gossip mills about what "So and so" did to me. The last thing we do, if we do it at all, is what the Lord said to do first - Go speak with him alone. If it settles the matter, the matter is settled, seal your lips! Approach him with humility, meekness and concern with hopes of saving his soul (Galatians 6:1; Luke 17:3).

Paired Confirmation. What if your private rebuke doesn't work? "*...take with you one or two more, that 'by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established'*" (Matthew 18:16). Your hope is that he might confess, repent and receive forgiveness (Acts 8:22; 1 John 1:9). But if this doesn't happen, you have witnesses for when you follow the next step the Lord gives.

Public Commission. If he still doesn't repent, "*...tell it to the church*"

(Matthew 18:17). The church has an obligation to confirm the sin, then issue a first and second admonition (Titus 3:10). This is often done by sending some spiritually strong men to speak with the sinner (Galatians 6:1) and/or by way of letters of exhortation from the church. Again, the hope is for the sinner to repent, but if this doesn't occur the church is to "*...let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector*" (Matthew 18:17). Jews had no social dealings with these two classes. Once the church (as a church) publically delivers "*such a one to Satan*" (1 Corinthians 5:5), each individual member has the responsibility to cut off all social activities with them. No more hunting, fishing and golfing together. No more Friday nights of dinner and cards, etc. Paul said "*Not even to eat with such a person*" (1 Corinthians 5:11). The hope is to "Shame" them into realizing the significance of their sin so perhaps they will return to the Lord (2 Thessalonians 3:14). The Lord doesn't teach "Shunning" (e.g. walking the other way when we see them at the grocery store). We continue to try and talk with them, send cards, etc. in order to encourage them to repent (2 Thessalonians 2:15) and come back to the Lord.

HUNGER AND THIRST FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS

Jesus said “*Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled*” (Matthew 5:6). A few years ago I saw something I’ve seen many times over the years. It’s nothing new; in fact, most of you are very familiar with the same situation. My little niece began to cry. Was she tired? Was she hurting? NO. She was hungry! As soon as she saw her mother pull out her bottle she got a smile on her face and began to reach for it. But my sister-in-law had some trouble getting the cap off the bottle, so the baby began to cry again. Why? Because she strongly desired that milk!

This reminds me of a story my mom likes telling from time to time. When I was a child and eating baby food from a jar; she would spoon feed it to me as all mothers do. However, it seemed she couldn’t feed it to me fast enough and I would scream out between each bite! (Things haven’t changed much huh? smile). Why did I scream? Because I had a strong desire for the food that was in that jar.

Think about that baby crying for

her bottle; think about me screaming for the next bite; if you will get these mental images in your mind, you will get the picture in your mind’s eye of how Jesus says we should desire spiritual food. Peter drew the same picture when he wrote, “*As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby*” (1 Peter 2:2). Do we really desire Bible study this much? Do we yearn so strongly for another taste of the word, for more spiritual knowledge, that we get upset when we don’t get to study it daily (Acts 17:11)? If not, we need to get with it! Paul commanded that we “*Understand what the will of the Lord is*” (Ephesians 5:17). This takes study!

If babies lacked the desire for their bottle and food they would refuse it and die. If Christians don’t develop a strong desire for more knowledge of the truths found in God’s holy word, they will die spiritually! Loving the truth leads to learning the truth, and this will equip us to teach others and avoid sin and error (1 Peter 3:15; 2 Thessalonians 2:9-10). 🔍
