Eliphaz reminds us that we “*Dwell in houses of clay, whose foundation is in the dust*” (Job 4:19). I’m inclined to believe him to be speaking, not of the house our bodies dwell in, but of the bodies our souls reside in.

As a man, I am made up of body and spirit (Soul). There will come a time when my spirit will depart from my body; this time is referred to as “Death” (James 2:26). If the Lord doesn’t return first, we all have an appointment with death (Hebrews 9:27). Depending on how I live while in this body, my spirit will finally end up in either heaven or hell (Matthew 25:46; 1 Peter 1:3-5; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9). Either way,

while on this earth I reside in a body of clay that has dust as its very foundation. This should certainly remind me of how fragile and perishable I am.

Paul spoke of this body as a “Tent” and how we who dwell in it long to be clothed with a body suitable for heaven (2 Corinthians 5:1-4). Peter tells us that heaven is a place where nothing perishes (“incorruptible”) (1 Peter 1:3-5).

When we enter heaven, there’ll be no more pain, no more debilitating diseases, no more shattered dreams, no more tragic accidents. While in these bodies of clay, we are subject to many ill effects that will vanish in eternity! ☞

AS CHRISTIANS. . .

A christian is a disciple of Christ (Acts 11:26). It’s a name given by the “*Mouth of the Lord*” (Isaiah 62:2). Its root word is “Christ” denoting that the christian is one who belongs to Christ and follows Him. As christians, consider...

Our Allegiance. Our allegiance is to Christ! Our loyalty and devotion to Him should trump all other loyalties. How sad that many have made the Lord a Lord of convenience. They’ll read His word daily (Acts 17:11) if they’re not too busy doing other “Important” things. They’ll do the right thing if it doesn’t embarrass them in front of their peers. They’ll come to worship services (Hebrews 10:25) if there’s not some other event going on that they “must attend.” It has been well said that in my life Christ is either Lord of all or he isn’t Lord at all (Matthew 10:37-39).

Our Adherence. We are to adhere, not to the doctrines and traditions of men, but to the Gospel of Christ. If we are truly Christ’s disciples we will refuse to transgress His doctrine even when it doesn’t make sense (2 John 9). Often, man’s ideas seem better than God’s way. But remember “*There is a way that seems right to a man, but its*

end is the way of death” (Proverbs 14:12). God’s thoughts and ways are far superior to ours (Isaiah 55:8-9). If it were possible for God to have a foolish thought, even that foolish thought would be far wiser than the wisest thought of the most brilliant man (1 Corinthians 1:25).

Many religious folks today are not satisfied with the words of Christ; they want to do things not found on the pages of inspiration. As a result, church services have become concerts and play time. Sermons have been reduced to entertaining Toastmasters productions, and “churches” have become nothing more than a social outlet for the young. Folks today need to be reminded of Paul’s words: “*Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus*” (Colossians 3:17). That is, only do those things the Lord has authorized in His Gospel.

Our Ardor. Before Christ, as individuals we worked at leading sinful lives. In Christ, we must labor for the Lord. Visit the sick, feed the hungry, clothe the naked, share the Gospel, etc (Matthew 25:31-46; Acts 8:4). We were created in Christ for these things (Ephesians 2:10) and our lives must abound in them (1 Corinthians 15:58). ☞

An insurance policy with low rates and great benefits? Sign me up! Sadly, people are not nearly as anxious as they should be to “Sign up” for spiritual security. It seems strange, really, when one considers the eternal benefits.

You see, for those who decide to follow Jesus on His terms, heaven is promised. Peter wrote, “*Blessed be the God and father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead...*” (1 Peter 1:3). He goes on in the next verse to explain how this eternal existence will be in a place where there will be no corruption. Imagine, these frail bodies of clay we reside in now, the ones that are subjected to disease, pain and the ravages of age, will be replaced with

eternal spiritual bodies that will never again know sickness, pain, or death (2 Corinthians 5:1-8). Sign me up! He then says that this place will be undefiled.
