SAVE YOURSELF!

Calvinism asserts that man's salvation is outside himself. That is, there's nothing he can do to effect his salvation. The idea that one should save himself is anathema to those who espouse Calvinism. Many Bible passages refute such a teaching, but none more clearly as the few that actually come right out and say that man is to save himself. Consider...

Peter's Words. In his sermon on Pentecost in Acts chapter two, Peter told His audience, "*Save yourselves from this crooked generation*" (Acts 2:40 -ESV). Although some modern translations translate the phrase "be saved," it's nice to see the relatively new English Standard Version bring back the accurate translation. The Greek word is *sozo* and it means to "Save (self)." Obviously God has a large part in our salvation; and Peter had just told the Jews what His part was. God sent the Son, The Son died on the cross making salvation available to all men; but the ball is now in man's court (So to speak). While God has made salvation available, man must choose to avail himself of that salvation through obedience to the Gospel (Acts 6:7; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9). He must save himself!

Paul's Writing. To the Philippians, Paul wrote, "*Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling*" (Philippians 2:12 – ESV, NKJV, etc.). In the same verse Paul had just stated, "*Therefore my beloved, as you have always obeyed...*" Paul recognized that man must obey the Gospel in order to be saved, and he must then continue to obey faithfully in order to finally receive eternal life. Paul understood that one must finish the race and keep the faith in order to receive the crown of life (2 Timothy 4:7-8). Paul realized that even preachers and apostles could become disqualified to receive the "Imperishable crown" (1 Corinthians 9:25-27). We work out our own salvation by remaining faithful to the Lord regardless of the temptations and trials we might face (Revelation 2:10). It is possible for one to wander from the truth and once again need his soul to be saved from death (James 5:19-20).

Preacher's Work. Paul told Timothy that by taking heed to the doctrine and continuing in it he would "*Save both yourself and those who hear you*" (1 Timothy 4:16). We do not earn our salvation through obedience and faithfulness, but we will not be saved unless we do both! Save Yourself! 🔍

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BURIED ALIVE!

“Buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.”

- Colossians 2:12 NKJV

The Greek word for “Baptism” is a word meaning “To dip, to plunge, to overwhelm, to immerse.” In fact, the word “Baptism” isn’t even a translation, it’s a transliteration. That is, if you transpose the Greek letters into English, you get something that looks like “Baptism.” But the word speaks of a burial.

Our passage above makes it clear that bible baptism is a burial. Not sprinkling, not pouring, but a burial! Philip and the Eunuch both went into the water and they both came up out of the water (Acts 8:38-39), meaningless actions if sprinkling were sufficient.

But the purpose of this article is to deal with the teaching that one is saved by faith first, then baptized in order to demonstrate that he has been saved. This is what a large majority of

“Christian” religions believe and teach. It is more popularly known as the “Faith Only” doctrine.

Many are the scriptural arguments we could offer to expose the falsity of this doctrine. For example, the Bible makes it clear that one must “Obey” if he wants eternal life (Hebrews 5:8-9) and that merely calling on His name audibly will not suffice (Matthew 7:21). But have they ever considered that they are literally burying a living soul? If one is saved before baptism, then when he is baptized he is buried alive!

An alien sinner is “Dead” in his trespasses and sins (Ephesians 2:1). What do we do with a dead person? We bury him! So, the dead sinner is “Buried with Him (Christ) in baptism...” (Colossians 2:12). He then rises to walk a new life. Why would the Bible teach that one is saved before baptism, but not require the saved person to walk in newness of life until after he is baptized? It Doesn’t! (Read Romans 6:1-5). 🔑
